In Brief



This is a monstrous circular walk from **Guildford to Haslemere and back** with access by car or British Rail. It takes you through some typical Surrey countryside, such as you find on some of the favourite country walks in this region. Along the way, you visit four especially picturesque villages, Hascombe, Chiddingfold, Tilbury and Puttenham, with a circuit of Hascombe Hill and a walk over the austere moorland of Kettlebury Hill. This walk goes through some wild terrain with few roads and there is very little road walking.

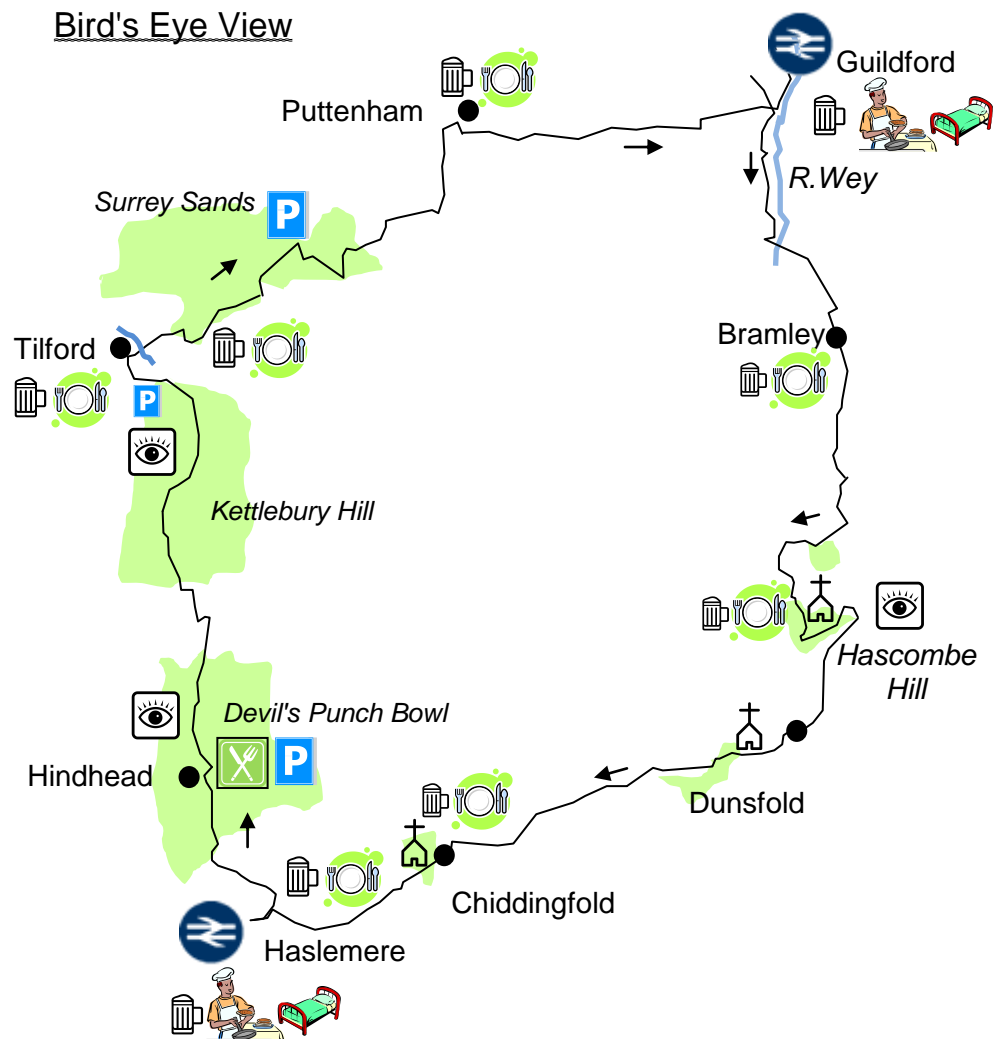
Warning! This is an *exceeding long* walk, requiring two days or all the daylight hours at midsummer. It should *not* be attempted unless you are physically extremely fit and have a medical kit and back-up support.



Boots are recommended because of the length of this walk. A hiking pole is also recommended. This monster walk is not suitable for a dog. Cover your legs!

The walk begins and ends at **Guildford Railway Station**, Surrey. It may also begin and end at **Haslemere Railway Station**. For full details, see *Getting There* at the end of either of the two constituent walks.

The Walk



This walk is divided into 8 easy “treks”, with full details in the two constituent monster walks.

Guildford to Haslemere:

- Trek 1 **Guildford to Bramley** 6¼ km=4 miles
- Trek 2 **Bramley to Hascombe** 7¼ km=4½ miles
- Trek 3 **Hascombe to Chiddingfold** 11 km=6½ miles
- Trek 4 **Chiddingfold to Haslemere** 7½ km=5 miles

Haslemere to Guildford:

Trek 1 **Haslemere to Hindhead.** 4 km=2½ miles

Trek 2 **Hindhead to Tilford.** 10 km=6½ miles

Trek 3 **Tilford to Puttenham.** 10 km=6½ miles

Trek 4 **Puttenham to Guildford.** 9 km=5½ miles

If you are staying overnight in Haslemere or continuing straight on, read the [blue](#) paragraph at the end of the first walk. You can also stay overnight in Guildford which has a large number of hotels, including *Holiday Inn*, *Travelodge*, etc. You can of course do both parts separately on different days.

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
